

Why Church? A Place of Grace

Matthew 20:1-16

Point of the Parable: In the kingdom of God, the last will be first, and the first will be last. That means: (Matthew 19:30, 20:16)

- We are on equal footing, standing together because of God's gracious generosity
 - We are unwise to grumble against God's gracious generosity
- Evenly the lowly and forgotten have a purpose and work in the kingdom of God.

We all have a place in God's Kingdom to enjoy and share in His Grace.

So, a few things that come out of this for me, and I think are important for the church:

What am I personally doing to show God's grace, reflect and live out God's kindness and generosity?

How am I valuing in the church family, "the least of these?" That is, how do I care about people and love them as Christ loved the world?

What activities in the church give prominence and importance to the less adorned in the world? Who are the forgotten and neglected in our own community that I can personally champion for and love?

Who in our world is often forgotten and neglected that I can champion and support?

This whole thing pushes us closer to the heart of Jesus, who welcomed sinners and tax collectors into life with him.

His own humility, not thinking too highly of himself is what brought him into the presence of people who truly needed him the most.

Why Church? Because we enjoy the riches of a gracious God, who would welcome even me, the least hirable of people into the work of His Kingdom. I have a place because of His Grace.
