

Philippians, the Book of Joy

July 5, Philippians 2: The Joy of Jesus

Jesus said, W , not I people insult you, persecute you and falsely sail all kinds of evil against you...

"[In Nigeria] there was the Christian father I spoke to from his hospital bed, where he was still recovering from a Boko Haram ambush in his village months ago. When armed jihadists demanded he convert to Islam from Christianity, the Christian answered, 'God forbid.'"

The attackers fatally shot his wife, and nearly killed him with a machete. He survives with a missing right arm, a severely wounded left arm, and five motherless children.

When I asked how I could pray for him, the Christian's answer was similar to many others suffering great loss in Nigeria: 'Pray that I will stand fast.'"
