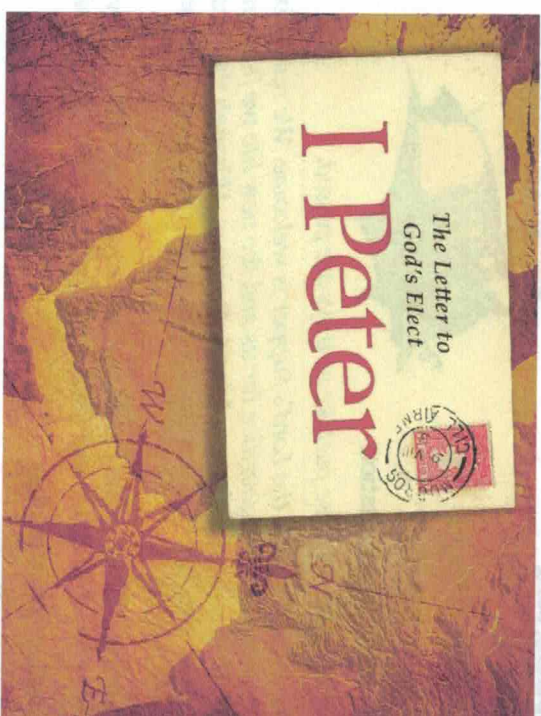

Suffering for Doing Good

1 Peter 2:18 – 3:15

The Purpose of this message is to call us to an enduring love and devotion to Jesus Christ.

As we look at the encouragement of Peter, we see that everything is rooted and established in the crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus.

We are able to suffer for doing good, because that is exactly what Jesus did.

How can we endure in our faith? We follow the lead of Jesus.

The example set for us is the reminder that our faith and hope in Jesus is not based on circumstances. Would we like for our marriage to be better, have a better job, or be freed from a particular suffering? We may want this. But our joy, our strength and our endurance within this is the result of Jesus and the resurrection from the dead.
