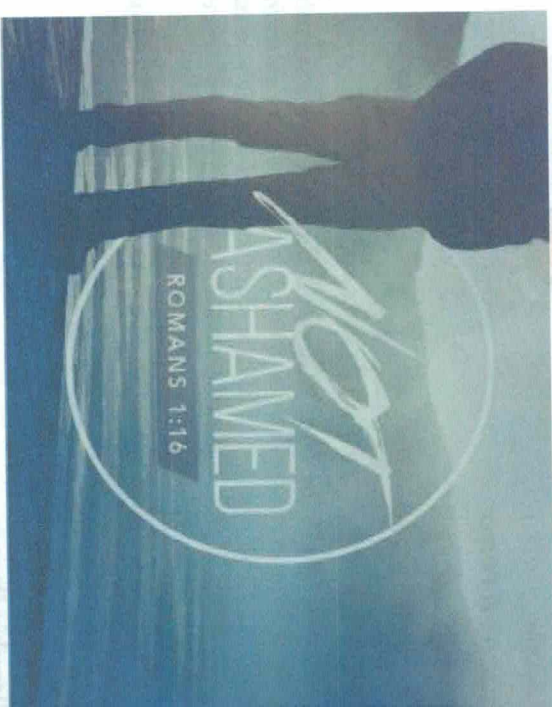

## Sermon Notes

### The Problem of sin, further exposed - 2:1-3:20

3:1-20 – We all need Jesus

#### Repentance - 2:1-4

##### A. The Problem of judging

We are limited in our understanding of any situation  
Judging leads to thinking ourselves morally superior

God's Kindness is meant to bring people to repentance

The great lengths God has gone through, are that humanity would return to him.  
Let's always remember that.

#### B. Unrepentant hearts appears to be the problem - 2:5-6

The result of a life of continual disobedience, disregard, will result in our own  
destruction.

God's judgment is just, and it is coming. Though many would deny it, scripture  
directs that there is judgment, we are all accountable to God.

#### C. What will your story be? - 2:7-11

The judgment is for all people, but there are two differing outcomes:

Repent, turn towards Christ leads to LIFE (Kingdom)

Be obedient to selfish desire will lead to judgment and trouble, distress, anger,  
fury!

#### D. How God's Impartial Judgment will work?

God judges all human secrets through King Jesus. Either Jew, or Gentile (Greek) –  
all people!

Repentance – turn from the self-seeking desires of our life prior to Christ, and  
begin pursuing the kingdom of God with our whole selves.

Understand the direction all of our lives were/are heading without Jesus – de-  
struction.

Remember God's Kindness today. He is still patient. He is still waiting. He is still  
waiting, that all people might be saved. Worship, Repent, Believe. These  
are appropriate responses to this Scripture.
