Proclaiming Christmas  
The Shepherd's Song  
Luke 2:1-20

The Shepherds story...  
They hear the angels.  
They go and see if it is true.  
Discover Jesus to be true  
They praise God.  
They go and tell others about what they've heard and seen.  
They continue their worship.

*The Church that is faithful: Embraces King, Jesus and his kingdom, Displays the Kingdom of God as a faithful, peaceful community, and also, Proclaims the availability of the Kingdom of God.*
