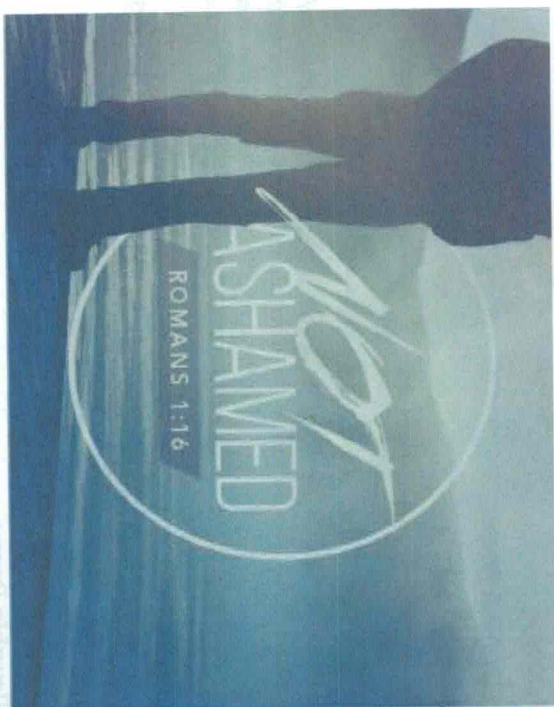

Sermon Notes

A Good and Beautiful Life

Romans 6

If sin is cared for by the grace of God, why does it matter how I live?

It's possible for us to take advantage of God's grace, but why would we? Are you asking if you can keep seeking satisfaction from the dumpster and at the same time live a life God desires you to live?

God's Grace is over our garbage, not grace for more garbage.

Christian Stockholm Syndrome defines people who were trapped by the captor of sin and death, and have convinced themselves that sin *isn't* as destructive as the Bible lets on. Christ releases the hostages to sin and death, but in the process they became friends with sin.

Points of interests in Romans 6:

We have gone from death to new life, we live the resurrection.

The basic Christian hope is that in Jesus we will be resurrected from the dead.

Our life is with Christ, we are dead to sin, and made alive in Jesus.

Death doesn't have control over Jesus.

We are instruments of righteousness, we are used for the glory of God.

We follow a new pattern for our life, one that reflects our new found allegiance to Jesus.

We no longer live in the things that from our past we are ashamed of, we know they lead to death!

The wages of sin is death, but the free gift is eternal life in God.

Response to the text:

Repentance 2) Remember who you belong to 3)turn frequently to the goodness of God 4) Celebrate the Resurrection 5) Baptism – join in the New Life in Jesus
