Sermon Notes

Victory because of Jesus

Romans 8

Phobos – “Fear” describes a state of severe distress, aroused by intense concern for impending pain, danger, evil, etc., or possibly by the illusion of such circumstances - fear

Huiothesias – “Adoption” is to formally and legally declare that someone who is not one’s own child is henceforth to be treated and cared for as one’s own child, including complete rights of inheritance.

Christians can face trouble and hardship because they are God’s children. We’ve been adopted by God, and treated “henceforth” as God’s children. Our inheritance is a life with God, now and in the future. Now, we call him “Abba” and one day, we will be with him in restored creation.

We don’t become like Jesus - “conformed to the image of his son” – by divorcing ourselves from suffering, but engaging suffering faithfully with hope. Because of the Cross and Resurrection of Jesus we know and believe that God can take the vilest evil (crucifixion of innocent man) and greatest suffering for the good of creation. God’s promise is something good can come from what was intended to harm! He does it with Jacob. He does it for Jesus. He does it for Paul. He does it for the Blind man. He does it for his Church, today!

God decided long ago he wouldn’t leave the world at a loss, but would redeem and save his creation.
