Sermon Notes

Why are you afraid?

1) Have you forgotten his **Presence** with you?

Mark 4:35–41 – Jesus Calms the Storm

Jesus resting his head on the pillow is a troubling thing to the disciples. They perceive it as a lack of concern from Jesus towards the disciples. “Don’t you care if we drown?” Yet that is the misperception of the situation. Jesus can rest in the midst of this storm because of a complete trust in God the Father.

2) Have you forgotten his **Power** to make right the world?

Mark 5:1–20 – Jesus heals the demon possessed man

In the face of evil, Jesus is stronger. Legion, a man, captured by demons, was an uncontrollable. The demons caused him great harm; nothing could be done to keep them man restrained.

There are times that evil seems uncontrollable. We do all we can, but it never seems enough to keep it at bay. Fear is a natural response to the presence of evil. Why are we afraid? Because evil is real, it lurks around us, and we don’t know what might happen. **But there is one who is greater.** And when his loving ministry comes in contact with the face of evil, to the sea it goes. Deep into the abyss. God vanquishes evil. **Don’t ever forget the power of God to make right the world.**

3) Why are you afraid? Have you forgotten the **Promise** of Victory?

Mark 9:30–32

Jesus is with his disciples, going about their business; here are the forces of evil (madmen shrieking in the synagogue, angry men plotting, powerful men capturing Jesus and putting him to death); here is Jesus, not now asleep on a pillow but slumped on the cross. We hear his voice: Why are you afraid? Don't you believe? And on the third day the storm is still, the tomb is empty, and great fear comes upon them all. Who then is this? – NT Wright

Remember his Promise. Remember his Presence. Remember his Power.

Romans 8:11–17,31–39

Why are you afraid, when the gravestone is rolled away and nothing remains that can separate you from the love of God in Jesus Christ?
