

## Sermon Notes

### Worshipping God – It's more than a Sunday!

#### Romans 12

Christians must “figure out how to think, speak and act in a way that is appropriate for the new age that is breaking in because of Christ Jesus.” – NT Wright

We live in a new reality. That reality is that Jesus is Lord and King over all of creation. We must live our lives differently because we believe in the new reality. We do not live our lives like the world. We don't let the world dictate to us how we are supposed to be acting and treating people. We don't come to church and treat one another the way that the world does. The terms and conditions of our relationship together is no longer dictated by who we used to be, but by who we are transformed to be in Jesus.

This passage is about the church, in humility, using the variety of gifts we've all been given, for the advancement of the gospel.

This is about a careful self-assessment that understands clearly how God has gifted you for the building up of the church and the equipping of ministry. Doing nothing, and doing too much are both prohibitive to the body of believers. All of us, in unison working together will keep the church on the right track of being a faithful witness in the world, expressing itself in love and peace.

Love keeps no records of wrongs. Consider that as we express sincere love towards one another and God the rest of March!
