Blueprints Week 2

Kindness

Deuteronomy 22:1-4 – *Don't withhold help.* I like to think of our congregation this week, wrangling up lost oxen. I can't imagine the scenario happening any time soon. But the implication of this text holds true, always; don't withhold helping others. The kindness we are to clothed in as Christians is as simple as helping our neighbor.

Proverbs 31:26 – The Proverbs 31 woman, one in which many women aspire to be, "opens her mouth with wisdom and the teaching of kindness is on her tongue." As we consider what it means to be a parent from Sunday's message, what is something that your mom told you about being kind? Can you do that today?

Zechariah 7:9-10 "Don't devise evil against one another." One of the things that we are to take off from our old self is gossip. How often do we devise evil for our enemies with the spread of falsehood?

Kindness is more than action, it is in our word and deeds. Take time today to think about how you speak about others. Be sure to have kind speech today!

Luke 6:34-35 – Love others, and expect nothing in return. That's the type of kindness we are looking to clothe ourselves. Pray, "Lord help me today to love others and not expect anything back in repayment."

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 – Love is kind. I hope this week, each day has been a reminder of God's love for you. How he has been patient, compassionate, merciful and kind towards you. Go, reflect the love of God today! You can do it!

Part 2: Parenting - Deuteronomy 6:1-9

The main goal of parenting is to teach children to love God and obey His Commandments. Deuteronomy 6:2

Parents must be aware and protect against cultural idols competing for our kid's attention and devotion. Without our direction, they will worship whatever makes them feel good and best in the moment.

The chief aim of parenting is not to keep our children busy and entertained. The worst thing our children can say is not, "I'm bored."

The chief aim of parenting is teaching them about Jesus, to follow him and obey his commandments. Our job as parents is to disciple our children into a faithful relationship with Jesus. The very best thing we can do for our kids is teach them to love God and others.

Deuteronomy 6:4-5 was the most important verse for the Israelite people. In a few short words, it told the story of God loving Israel. It was common for them to recite the verse morning and evening. It shaped their identity.

Similarly, we are to let the story of Scripture shape us and our identity. Kids are looking for an identity in something. Will you show it to be their true identity in Jesus?

Moses' timeless parenting guide: Deuteronomy 6:5-9

The first step to teach our children to love the Lord is to have the commandments on our own heart first. We can't influence our kids with the Word of God if the Word of God isn't influencing us.

Step 2 – is to impress this on our kids. It's about being intentional in our conversation – Season your conversations with your children about the love of God. As a parent, will you be much more intentional about teaching your kids about God?

Step 3 – Inundate your life in the Word. Hang scripture from your walls and let it ooze out of your heart. Saturate the space of your life in the Word of God. When you walk, talk. When you wake, speak of God's love.
