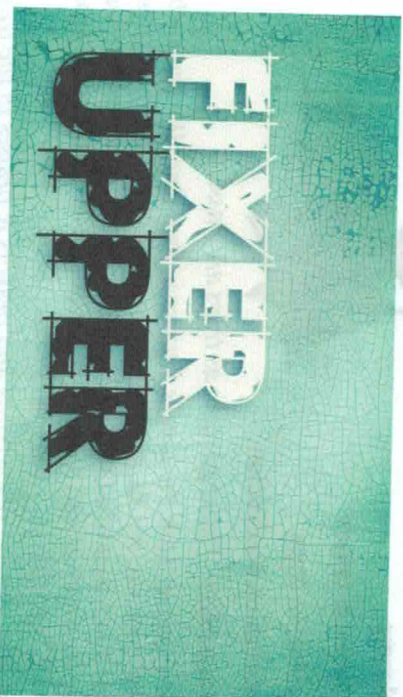

## Sermon Notes

### Love is Kind

1 Corinthians 13:4

Luke 6:27-36

1 Peter 2:1-3

Phil Kenneson, life on the Vine - "We know from the early church fathers that many people during the first century were confused about what these strange followers of Jesus were called. Because the Greek word for Christ (Christos) was so similar to the word for "Kind" (Chrestos), apparently many people mistakenly (though perhaps fittingly) called Jesus' early followers not "Christians" but "The kind ones."

If we want to be recognized as the "kind ones" in our community, we need to love as Christ calls us to:

1. Do good to those who hate you.
  2. Bless those who curse at you
  3. Pray for those who treat you terribly.
  4. Give the coat off your back.
  5. Don't retaliate with the intent of harming people.
  6. Give to everyone who asks you.
  7. Don't demand back what you believe you are missing.
- Ultimately, it all comes down to 31 - "Treat others the way you want to be treated."
- 1 Peter 2:3 - "now that you have tasted that the Lord is good (Chrestos)."

Now that you've tasted and experienced the kindness of God, go and do likewise. Treat others the way God has treated you.
